

**HOUSE RESOLUTION 10**

[2002 First Special Session]

Whereas over 3,000 innocent men, women and children were brutally murdered in New York City, Washington, D.C., and Pennsylvania in the abhorrent and cowardly terrorist attacks on the United States on September 11, 2001; and

Whereas many of those victims were firefighters, police officers, medical and rescue personnel and civilians who were trying to save the lives of their fellow Americans; and

Whereas countless lives were saved by the heroic efforts of many of the victims; and

Whereas the victims and their families represent the great diversity of races, religions and ethnicities found within the United States; and

Whereas today is the first day the Oregon Legislative Assembly has met since September 11, 2001; now, therefore,

**Be It Resolved by the House of Representatives of the State of Oregon:**

That we, the members of the House of Representatives of the special session of the Seventy-first Legislative Assembly, hereby honor the memory of those who lost their lives in the September 11, 2001, attacks and express our profound sympathy for the loved ones they left behind; and be it further

Resolved, That a copy of this resolution be sent to the Governor of the State of New York, the Governor of the State of Pennsylvania, the Mayor of the City of New York, the Mayor of the District of Columbia and all members of the Oregon Congressional Delegation.
