SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Requires Oregon Department of Administrative Services to adopt rules concerning property rental or leasing rates charged by state agencies that rent or lease property or facilities to other state agencies. Requires department to review rates biennially and report to Joint Legislative Committee on Ways and Means.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

Relating to state agencies leasing property to other state agencies.

Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:

SECTION 1. (1) The Oregon Department of Administrative Services shall adopt rules to ensure that the property rental or leasing rates charged by a state agency that furnishes property or facilities to another state agency are competitive with property rental or leasing rates charged in the private sector.

(2) The department shall review biennially the property rental and leasing rates of state agencies that rent or lease property or facilities to other state agencies.

(3) Before January 1 of each odd-numbered year, the department shall report the findings and any recommendations resulting from the biennial review to the Joint Legislative Committee on Ways and Means.
