SUMMARY

Allows Legislative Counsel to change geographic references in statute if new references are approved by Oregon Geographic Names Board and United States Board on Geographic Names.

Relating to geographic names.

Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:

SECTION 1. The Legislative Counsel may substitute for a term in statute that designates a geographic place, any term for the geographic place that is approved by the:

(1) Oregon Geographic Names Board; and

(2) United States Board on Geographic Names.

NOTE: Matter in **boldfaced** type in an amended section is new; matter [*italic and bracketed*] is existing law to be omitted. New sections are in **boldfaced** type.
