

# House Bill 2254

Ordered printed by the Speaker pursuant to House Rule 12.00A (5). Pre-session filed (at the request of Joint Interim Committee on Judiciary for Office of Legislative Counsel)

## SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Modifies definition of child care facility for purposes of obtaining liability insurance coverage.

## A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to child care facility liability insurance coverage; amending ORS 278.322.

3 **Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

4 **SECTION 1.** ORS 278.322 is amended to read:

5 278.322. (1) A child care [*center, as defined by rule of the Department of Human Services*] **facility**  
6 **as defined in ORS 657A.250**, and a private child-caring agency as defined in ORS 418.205 that meets  
7 the [*specifications*] **criteria** of subsection (2) of this section, may obtain insurance in the same man-  
8 ner as a local public body may obtain insurance under ORS 30.282. However, the insurance shall  
9 not cover theft or bodily injury and property damage arising out of operation of a motor vehicle by  
10 a child resident of the [*center*] **facility or agency**.

11 (2) A private child-caring agency is eligible to obtain insurance as specified in subsection (1) of  
12 this section if [*it*] **the agency**:

13 (a) Is run by a private, nonprofit agency;

14 (b) Is licensed by the state; and

15 (c) Provides residential treatment for children who have been placed in the care and custody  
16 of the state.
