SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure.

Expands assault in first degree to include intentionally or knowingly causing serious physical injury to child under[13] **six** years of age. Establishes conditions for term of post-prison supervision of person sentenced for violation.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to assault; creating new provisions; and amending ORS 163.185.

3 **Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

4 **SECTION 1.** ORS 163.185 is amended to read:

5 163.185. (1) A person commits the crime of assault in the first degree if the person:

6 (a) Intentionally causes serious physical injury to another by means of a deadly or dangerous
7 weapon; or

8 (b) **Intentionally or knowingly causes serious physical injury to a child under six years**
9 **of age.**

10 (2) Assault in the first degree is a Class A felony.

11 **SECTION 2.** **A person sentenced to a term of imprisonment for violating ORS 163.185**
12 **(1)(b) shall serve a term of post-prison supervision that shall continue until the term of the**
13 **post-prison supervision, when added to the term of imprisonment served, equals the maxi-**
14 **imum statutory indeterminate sentence for the violation. Any costs incurred as a result of**
15 **this section shall be paid by increased post-prison supervision fees under ORS 423.570.**
