SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Requires Department of Human Services to consider how department can provide immunizations to persons not currently served by department and to report recommendations to Legislative Assembly by May 1, 2005.

Declares emergency, effective on passage.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to immunizations provided by the Department of Human Services; and declaring an emer-
3 gency.

4 **Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

5 **SECTION 1. (1) The Department of Human Services shall consider methods by which the**
6 **department can provide immunizations through its immunization programs to persons who**
7 **are not currently served by the department.**

8 **(2) The department shall report its recommendations for providing immunizations to**
9 **persons who are not currently served by the department to the Legislative Assembly in the**
10 **manner required by ORS 192.245 by May 1, 2005.**

11 **SECTION 2. This 2005 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public**
12 **peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2005 Act takes effect**
13 **on its passage.**
