

House Bill 2358

Sponsored by Representative HASS; Senator BATES

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Directs Department of Education to award grants to school districts and public charter schools to provide automated external defibrillators in public school facilities.

Declares emergency, effective July 1, 2005.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

1
2 Relating to automated external defibrillators; and declaring an emergency.

3 **Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

4 **SECTION 1. Section 2 of this 2005 Act shall be known as the Graeme Jones Memorial**
5 **Act.**

6 **SECTION 2. (1) As used in this section, "public school facility" means a building or pre-**
7 **manufactured structure used by a school district or public charter school to provide educa-**
8 **tional services to children.**

9 **(2) In addition to those moneys distributed through the State School Fund, the Depart-**
10 **ment of Education shall award grants to school districts and public charter schools to pro-**
11 **vide automated external defibrillators in public school facilities.**

12 **(3) The goal of the grant program is to provide automated external defibrillators in at**
13 **least two public school facilities in each school district.**

14 **(4) Each school district and public charter school may apply for a grant under this sec-**
15 **tion. The amount of any grant received by a school district or public charter school under**
16 **this section may not exceed 60 percent of the actual costs for which grant funds may be used**
17 **under subsection (5) of this section.**

18 **(5) Any school district or public charter school that receives grant funds under this**
19 **section shall use the funds for:**

20 **(a) Purchasing or leasing automated external defibrillators to be placed in public school**
21 **facilities;**

22 **(b) Providing training to school district and public charter school employees and volun-**
23 **teers on the use of automated external defibrillators; and**

24 **(c) Any other expense related to providing automated external defibrillators in public**
25 **school facilities if the expense is approved by the Department of Education.**

26 **(6) The State Board of Education shall adopt rules:**

27 **(a) To establish criteria for awarding grants based on the goal set forth in subsection (3)**
28 **of this section;**

29 **(b) To determine the amount of each grant pursuant to subsection (4) of this section; and**

30 **(c) That are necessary for the administration of this section.**

31 **(7) The Department of Education shall seek federal grant funds under the Community**

1 **Access to Emergency Defibrillation Act of 2002, P.L. 107-188, section 159, and from any other**
2 **appropriate federal grant program that provides funds for public access to automated ex-**
3 **ternal defibrillators.**

4 **(8) For purposes of the grant program, the Department of Education may accept contri-**
5 **butions of funds and assistance from the United States Government and its agencies or from**
6 **any other source, public or private, and agree to conditions placed on the funds not incon-**
7 **sistent with the purposes of the grant program.**

8 **(9) All funds received by the Department of Education under this section shall be paid**
9 **into the Department of Education Account established in ORS 326.115 to the credit of the**
10 **grant program.**

11 **SECTION 3. This 2005 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public**
12 **peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2005 Act takes effect**
13 **July 1, 2005.**
