

HOUSE AMENDMENTS TO HOUSE BILL 2361

1 On page 1 of the printed bill, delete lines 15 through 19 and insert:

2 “(2)(a) A person whose driving privileges are revoked as described in subsection (1) of this sec-
3 tion may file a petition in the circuit court of the county in which the person resides for an order
4 restoring the person’s driving privileges. A petition may be filed under this subsection no sooner
5 than 10 years after the person is:

6 “(A) Released on parole or post-prison supervision; or

7 “(B) Sentenced to probation if the probation is not revoked and the person is thereafter dis-
8 charged without the imposition of a sentence of imprisonment.

9 “(b) The district attorney of the county in which the person resides shall be named and served
10 as the respondent in the petition.”.

11 On page 2, delete lines 13 through 17 and insert:

12 “**SECTION 3. The amendments to ORS 809.235 and 813.400 by sections 1 and 2 of this 2005**
13 **Act apply to persons whose third or subsequent conviction of misdemeanor driving while**
14 **under the influence of intoxicants occurs on or after the effective date of this 2005 Act.**”.
