

HOUSE AMENDMENTS TO HOUSE BILL 2362

- 1 On page 1 of the printed bill, line 2, delete “appropriating money;”.
- 2 On page 2, line 10, delete “Task Force” and insert “Interim Committee”.
- 3 In line 11, delete “20” and insert “four”.
- 4 In line 12, delete “one member” and insert “two members”.
- 5 In line 14, delete “one member” and insert “two members”.
- 6 Delete lines 16 through 36.
- 7 In line 37, delete “task force” and insert “interim committee”.
- 8 In line 43, delete “task force shall study” and insert “interim committee shall design”.
- 9 On page 3, line 25, delete “task force” and insert “interim committee”.
- 10 Delete lines 30 through 45 and insert:
- 11 “(6) The interim committee shall appoint an advisory committee to assist the interim committee
- 12 in carrying out its purpose as described in subsection (3) of this section. Persons appointed to the
- 13 advisory committee shall:
- 14 “(a) Have expertise related to the public funding and provision of general and special education,
- 15 child welfare, juvenile justice, child and family mental health, developmental disabilities or chil-
- 16 dren’s health care services; or
- 17 “(b) Have experience caring for or advocating on behalf of children with severe emotional or
- 18 mental disorders who are involved in multiple public systems.
- 19 “(7) Persons appointed to the advisory committee are not entitled to compensation or re-
- 20 imbursement for expenses and serve as volunteers on the advisory committee.
- 21 “(8) The President of the Senate and the Speaker of the House of Representatives shall select
- 22 one member of the interim committee to serve as chairperson and another to serve as vice chair-
- 23 person, with the duties and powers necessary for the performance of the functions of the offices as
- 24 the President and the Speaker determine.
- 25 “(9) A majority of the members of the interim committee constitutes a quorum for the trans-
- 26 action of business.
- 27 “(10) Official action by the interim committee requires the approval of a majority of the mem-
- 28 bers of the interim committee.
- 29 “(11) If there is a vacancy for any cause, the appointing authority shall make an appointment
- 30 to become immediately effective.
- 31 “(12) The interim committee shall meet at times and places specified by the call of the chair-
- 32 person or of a majority of the members of the interim committee.
- 33 “(13) The interim committee may adopt rules necessary for the operation of the interim com-
- 34 mittee.
- 35 “(14) The interim committee shall report to the Legislative Assembly in the manner provided in

1 ORS 192.245 at any time within 30 days after its final meeting or at such later time as the President
2 and Speaker may designate.

3 “(15) The Legislative Administrator may employ persons necessary for the performance of the
4 functions of the interim committee. The Legislative Administrator shall fix the duties and amounts
5 of compensation of these employees. The interim committee shall use the services of permanent
6 legislative staff to the greatest extent practicable.

7 “(16) All agencies of state government, as defined in ORS 174.111, are directed to assist the in-
8 terim committee in the performance of its duties and, to the extent permitted by laws relating to
9 confidentiality, to furnish such information and advice as the members of the interim committee
10 consider necessary to perform their duties.”.
