SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Requires Governor to obtain approval of Legislative Assembly prior to approving siting of Indian tribal gaming establishment on lands acquired by Indian tribe after October 17, 1988.

Relating to Indian gaming.

Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:

SECTION 1. Prior to making a determination to approve an Indian tribal gaming establishment pursuant to 25 U.S.C. 2719 on lands acquired by an Indian tribe after October 17, 1988, if the Governor's determination will be to approve the gaming establishment, the Governor shall obtain approval of that action by the Legislative Assembly.
