

HOUSE AMENDMENTS TO HOUSE BILL 2603

By COMMITTEE ON BUSINESS, LABOR AND CONSUMER AFFAIRS

1 On page 1 of the printed bill, delete lines 4 through 25 and insert:

2 **“SECTION 1.** ORS 56.140 is amended to read:

3 **“56.140. (1) Except as provided in subsections (2) and (3) of this section,** the Secretary of
4 State shall collect a nonrefundable fee of \$50 for each document delivered for filing to the Secretary
5 of State as part of the secretary’s business registry functions described in ORS 56.022.

6 **“(2) Except as provided in subsection (3) of this section, as part of the secretary’s busi-**
7 **ness registry functions described in ORS 56.022, the secretary shall collect a nonrefundable**
8 **fee of \$20 for:**

9 **“(a) Each annual report filed with the secretary;**

10 **“(b) Each renewal of a registration of a trademark filed under ORS 647.055;**

11 **“(c) Each renewal of a registration of an assumed business name filed under ORS 648.017;**
12 **and**

13 **“(d) Each document delivered for filing to the secretary under ORS chapter 65.**

14 **“(3) For each nonprofit corporation that is a historic cemetery listed with the Oregon**
15 **Commission on Historic Cemeteries under ORS 97.782, the secretary may not collect any fee**
16 **for documents delivered for filing to the secretary as part of the secretary’s business regis-**
17 **try functions described in ORS 56.022.**

18 **“[(2)] (4) The Secretary of State by rule may establish fees, in addition to those provided for in**
19 **[subsection (1)] subsections (1), (2) and (3) of this section, for:**

20 **“(a) Copying any public record maintained by the secretary and relating to the secretary’s**
21 **business registry functions, and for certifying the copy; and**

22 **“(b) Certifying to other facts of record, including certificates of existence, relating to the sec-**
23 **retary’s business registry functions.**

24 **“[(3)] (5) The Secretary of State shall collect a nonrefundable fee of \$20 each time process is**
25 **served on the Secretary of State and the process relates to the secretary’s business registry func-**
26 **tions.**

27 **“[(4)] (6) The Secretary of State may waive collection of any fee, charge or interest, or portion**
28 **of a fee, charge or interest, that is collectible by the Secretary of State as part of the secretary’s**
29 **business registry functions.**

30 **“[(5)] (7) The Secretary of State by rule shall establish and collect reasonable fees for the fol-**
31 **lowing services relating to the secretary’s business registry functions:**

32 **“(a) Computer generated lists on electronic data processing media.**

33 **“(b) Terminal access to the files of the office.**

34 **“(c) Microfilm records of the files of the office.**

35 **“(d) Microfilm processing and development services.**

- 1 “(e) Copies of the programs and files on paper or electronic data processing media.”

- 3 In line 11, after “56.140” insert “(1)”.
