

House Bill 2661

Sponsored by Representative ROSENBAUM

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Prohibits employer from discriminating against individual because individual uses, applies to use or has used accrued and available sick leave in accordance with collective bargaining agreement or employer policy.

2 Relating to employment discrimination.

3 **Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

4 **SECTION 1. Section 2 of this 2005 Act is added to and made a part of ORS chapter 659A.**

5 **SECTION 2. It is an unlawful employment practice for an employer to discriminate**
6 **against an individual with respect to hire or tenure or any term or condition of employment**
7 **because the individual uses, applies to use or has used accrued and available sick leave in**
8 **accordance with a collective bargaining agreement or employer policy.**
