

House Bill 2673

Sponsored by Representatives HUNT, TOMEI; Representatives BOONE, DALLUM, JENSON, KOMP, NELSON, SCHAUFLEER, Senators MORSE, WESTLUND

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Directs school districts to distribute information to students about medical assistance program of Oregon Health Plan and Children's Health Insurance Program. Directs Office of Medical Assistance Programs to provide information to school districts.

Declares emergency, effective July 1, 2005.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

Relating to distribution of information to students by school districts; and declaring an emergency.

Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:

SECTION 1. At least once each school year, each school district shall distribute information regarding the medical assistance program of the Oregon Health Plan and the Children's Health Insurance Program to students who attend public school within the school district. The Office of Medical Assistance Programs shall provide information for distribution to the school districts about the programs. The information shall include income eligibility guidelines and information on obtaining an application for the programs. The office may provide additional information about the programs to the school districts for distribution to students.

SECTION 2. Section 1 of this 2005 Act first applies to the 2005-2006 school year.

SECTION 3. This 2005 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2005 Act takes effect July 1, 2005.
