

# House Bill 2703

Sponsored by Representative BERGER; Representatives BURLEY, DALLUM, DALTO, ESQUIVEL, KITTS, KROPF, RILEY, ROBLAN, G SMITH, SUMNER, WHISNANT

## SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Requires State Board of Parole and Post-Prison Supervision, Department of Corrections or community corrections agency to notify residents when person under supervision after conviction for manufacturing methamphetamine lives within certain proximity to residents.

## A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to methamphetamine.

3 **Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

4 **SECTION 1. (1) The agency responsible for supervising a person described in subsection**  
5 **(2) of this section shall notify residents living within one-quarter mile of the person that the**  
6 **person is residing in the area.**

7 **(2) Subsection (1) of this section applies to a person who:**

8 **(a) Is released on any form of supervised release from a jail, prison or other corrections**  
9 **facility in this state in which the person has been confined as a result of a conviction for**  
10 **manufacture of methamphetamine; or**

11 **(b) Is released on probation by a court after being convicted of manufacture of meth-**  
12 **amphetamine.**

13 **(3) The agency shall make the notification required by subsection (1) of this section no**  
14 **later than 10 days after the person is released and no later than 10 days after the person**  
15 **changes residence. The agency may use any method of communication that the agency de-**  
16 **termines is appropriate in making the notification. The notification may include, but need**  
17 **not be limited to, distribution of the following information:**

18 **(a) The person's name and address;**

19 **(b) A physical description of the person including, but not limited to, the person's age,**  
20 **height, weight and eye and hair color;**

21 **(c) Any conditions or restrictions upon the person's probation or post-prison supervision;**

22 **(d) A current photograph of the person; and**

23 **(e) The name or telephone number of the person's parole and probation officer.**  
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**NOTE:** Matter in **boldfaced** type in an amended section is new; matter *[italic and bracketed]* is existing law to be omitted. New sections are in **boldfaced** type.
