SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure.

[Prohibits school districts and education service districts from using moneys received from State School Fund for school lunch or breakfast programs.]

Directs Department of Education to annually notify school districts about resources available to assist in operation of self-supporting school breakfast and lunch programs.

Declares emergency, effective July 1, 2005.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

Relating to school finance; and declaring an emergency.

Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:

SECTION 1. Each school year, the Department of Education shall notify all school districts about the resources available from the department to assist school districts in operating school breakfast and lunch programs that are self-supporting.

SECTION 2. This 2005 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2005 Act takes effect July 1, 2005.
