

# House Bill 2739

Sponsored by Representative BOQUIST (at the request of Rachel Crawford)

## SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Directs State Parks and Recreation Director to adopt rules that make state funding assistance available to nonprofit veterans' organizations to construct and restore veterans and war memorials located on public property.

## A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to memorials; amending ORS 390.180.

3 **Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

4 **SECTION 1.** ORS 390.180 is amended to read:

5 390.180. (1) The State Parks and Recreation Director shall adopt rules that:

6 (a) Establish the standards the State Parks and Recreation Department shall use when that de-  
7 partment:

8 (A) Performs comprehensive statewide recreational planning; or

9 (B) Disburses any moneys to local governments or other state agencies under programs estab-  
10 lished under state or federal law.

11 (b) Establish a process for the development of a master plan for each state park, including public  
12 participation and coordination with affected local governments.

13 (c) Establish a master plan for each state park, including an assessment of resources and a de-  
14 termination of the capacity for public use and enjoyment of each park, that the State Parks and  
15 Recreation Department shall follow in its development and use of each park.

16 **(d) Make state funding assistance available to nonprofit veterans' organizations for the**  
17 **construction and restoration of memorials honoring veterans and war memorials located on**  
18 **public property.**

19 (2) The State Parks and Recreation Director shall submit an adopted state park master plan to  
20 the local government with land use planning responsibility for the subject park.
