SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Removes limitation on small employers that may be offered health benefit plans for small employers by Insurance Pool Governing Board.

Declares emergency, effective on passage.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

Relating to health benefit plans offered by Insurance Pool Governing Board; repealing section 2b, chapter 742, Oregon Laws 2003; and declaring an emergency.

Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:

SECTION 1. Section 2b, chapter 742, Oregon Laws 2003, is repealed.

SECTION 2. This 2005 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2005 Act takes effect on its passage.
