

House Bill 2794

Sponsored by Representative BUTLER; Representative KITTS

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Provides that sheriff has supervisory and final authority over county local correctional facilities, lockups, temporary holds and corrections supervision services.

Provides that unit of county government that employs certified police officers or corrections officers is under direct supervision and authority of county sheriff.

2 Relating to county sheriffs.

3 **Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

4 **SECTION 1. Section 2 of this 2005 Act is added to and made a part of ORS 169.320 to**
5 **169.360.**

6 **SECTION 2. (1) The sheriff of a county has supervisory and final authority over county**
7 **local correctional facilities, lockups, temporary holds and corrections supervision services.**

8 **(2) A county community corrections, parole and probation or corrections supervision**
9 **department, division or unit that is placed under the supervision of the sheriff by subsection**
10 **(1) of this section is subject to the sheriff's authority under ORS 206.210.**

11 **(3) Any unit of county government that employs police officers or corrections officers**
12 **certified by the Department of Public Safety Standards and Training is under the direct**
13 **supervision and authority of the county sheriff.**
