

House Bill 2866

Sponsored by COMMITTEE ON VETERANS' AFFAIRS

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Appropriates money from General Fund to Oregon Department of Administrative Services for Travel Information Council to repair Camp Adair historical markers.
Declares emergency, effective July 1, 2005.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

1
2 Relating to state financial administration; appropriating money; and declaring an emergency.

3 **Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

4 **SECTION 1. There is appropriated to the Oregon Department of Administrative Services,**
5 **for the biennium beginning July 1, 2005, out of the General Fund, the amount of \$20,000 for**
6 **the Travel Information Council. The department shall transfer the moneys to the council to**
7 **repair the historical markers for Camp Adair, which are located on the east side of Oregon**
8 **Route 99W.**

9 **SECTION 2. The Travel Information Council shall make a report to the Oregon Depart-**
10 **ment of Administrative Services, signed and certified by the chairperson of the council,**
11 **showing how the moneys appropriated by section 1 of this 2005 Act have been used. Any**
12 **moneys not used for the purpose specified in section 1 of this 2005 Act shall be transferred**
13 **by the council to the department for deposit into the General Fund.**

14 **SECTION 3. This 2005 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public**
15 **peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2005 Act takes effect**
16 **July 1, 2005.**
