

House Bill 2867

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Directs cities to distribute _____ percent of moneys received by cities from violations of laws and ordinances related to parking privileges for disabled persons to organizations that serve persons with disabilities.

Relating to cities.

Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:

SECTION 1. (1) Each city shall identify the amount of moneys the city receives as a result of violations of ORS 811.615, 811.617, 811.625 and 811.627 and city ordinances dealing with parking privileges for disabled persons.

(2) Each city shall distribute _____ percent of the amount identified under subsection (1) of this section to organizations that provide services to persons with disabilities.
