SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure.

Authorizes one percent of appropriations for construction, reconstruction or major renovation of public building to be expended to include **cost-effective** solar energy design and technology in building.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to inclusion of solar energy technologies in public buildings.

3 **Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

4 **SECTION 1. Section 2 of this 2005 Act is added to and made a part of ORS 279C.005 to**
5 **279C.670.**

6 **SECTION 2. (1) All appropriations for the construction, reconstruction or major reno-**
7 **vation of a public building are considered to contain an appropriation of one percent of the**
8 **amount of the appropriation for the inclusion of cost-effective solar energy design and tech-**
9 **nology in the building. Solar energy design and technology may include daylighting, passive**
10 **or active strategies.**

11 **(2) When it would not be appropriate to include solar energy design or technology in a**
12 **public building, the funds authorized in subsection (1) of this section may be expended to**
13 **include solar energy designs or technologies in other buildings under the control of the con-**
14 **tracting agency.**

15 **SECTION 3. Section 2 of this 2005 Act applies only to funds appropriated on or after the**
16 **effective date of this 2005 Act.**
