

House Bill 3062

Sponsored by COMMITTEE ON TRADE AND ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Eliminates appointment by President of Senate of cochairperson of Legislative Committee on Trade and Economic Development. Requires committee to meet regularly during sessions of Legislative Assembly and interims between sessions.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to Legislative Committee on Trade and Economic Development; amending ORS 171.805.

3 **Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

4 **SECTION 1.** ORS 171.805 is amended to read:

5 171.805. (1) The Legislative Committee on Trade and Economic Development is established as
6 a joint committee of the Legislative Assembly.

7 (2) The [*Legislative Committee on Trade and Economic Development shall consist*] **committee**
8 **consists** of the Speaker of the House of Representatives, the President of the Senate, six members
9 of the House appointed by the Speaker of the House of Representatives, at least one of whom
10 [*shall*] **must** have served on the committee in the preceding interim between legislative sessions,
11 and five members of the Senate appointed by the President of the Senate, at least one of whom
12 [*shall*] **must** have served on the committee in the preceding interim between legislative sessions.

13 (3) The appointing authorities shall appoint members of a new committee within 30 days after
14 the convening of the Legislative Assembly in regular session.

15 [(3)] (4) The Speaker of the House of Representatives and the President of the Senate may each
16 designate an alternate from among the members of the respective house [*from time to time*] to exer-
17 cise powers as a member of the committee when the Speaker or the President is not in attendance
18 at a meeting of the committee except that the alternate [*shall*] **may** not preside if the Speaker or
19 President is chairperson.

20 [(4)] (5) The term of a member of the committee [*shall expire*] **expires** upon the convening of the
21 Legislative Assembly in regular session next following the member's appointment. Vacancies occur-
22 ring in the membership of the committee shall be filled by the appointing authority.

23 [(5)] (6) The committee has a continuing existence and [*may*] **shall** meet, act and conduct its
24 business **regularly** during the sessions of the Legislative Assembly or any recess [*thereof,*] and in
25 the interim [*period*] between sessions.

26 [(6) *The cochairpersons, one from each house, shall preside alternately during the regular session*
27 *of the Legislative Assembly. The chairperson and vice chairperson shall be alternated between the*
28 *Senate and the House of Representatives each interim.*]

29 (7) **The Speaker of the House of Representatives shall appoint a member of the commit-**
30 **tee to serve as chair.**

31 [(7)] (8) The committee may appoint advisory committees or subcommittees[, *which*] **that** may

1 include individuals other than members of the Legislative Assembly. A member of such committee
2 or subcommittee who is not a member of the Legislative Assembly shall be compensated and reim-
3 bursed in the manner provided in ORS 292.495.

4 ~~[(8)]~~ **(9)** The President of the Senate and the Speaker of the House of Representatives, jointly,
5 shall appoint an executive officer who ~~[shall serve]~~ **serves** at their pleasure. Subject to the approval
6 of appointing authorities, the executive officer may appoint such other staff as is necessary to carry
7 out the functions of the committee.
