

HOUSE AMENDMENTS TO HOUSE BILL 3063

By COMMITTEE ON TRADE AND ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT

1 Delete lines 4 through 22 of the printed bill and insert:

2 **“SECTION 1. (1) The State Department of Agriculture shall conduct or provide for a**
3 **feasibility study to determine whether a livestock quarantine facility could be successfully**
4 **constructed and operated for the primary purpose of certifying disease-free livestock for**
5 **export to other countries. The study shall include, but need not be limited to:**

6 **“(a) An analysis of the market demand for the facility;**

7 **“(b) An analysis of engineering design alternatives and construction cost estimates;**

8 **“(c) The identification of possible participants in the design, construction and operation**
9 **of the facility;**

10 **“(d) The identification of possible funding sources; and**

11 **“(e) The need for legislation in support of the facility.**

12 **“(2) The department shall report the study findings, and any department recommen-**
13 **dations for legislation in support of the facility, to the Seventy-third Legislative Assembly in**
14 **the manner provided by ORS 192.245 no later than October 1, 2006.**

15 **“SECTION 2. In addition to and not in lieu of any other appropriation, there is appro-**
16 **priated to the State Department of Agriculture, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2005, out**
17 **of the General Fund, the amount of \$75,000, which may be expended for conducting or pro-**
18 **viding for the study described in section 1 of this 2005 Act.”.**
