

**SENATE AMENDMENTS TO
B-ENGROSSED HOUSE BILL 3092
(INCLUDING AMENDMENTS TO RESOLVE CONFLICTS)**

1 In line 2 of the printed B-engrossed bill, after the first semicolon delete the rest of the line and
2 insert “amending ORS 455.483; repealing section 2, chapter 288, Oregon Laws 2005 (Enrolled House
3 Bill 3304); and declaring an emergency.”.

4 Delete lines 4 through 17 and insert:

5 “**SECTION 1.** ORS 455.483 is amended to read:

6 “455.483. (1) The Department of Consumer and Business Services, with the approval of the [*ap-*
7 *propriate advisory boards*] **Electrical and Elevator Board**, shall adopt rules [*applicable in all ju-*
8 *risdictions in the state*] to make electrical [*and plumbing*] code plan review mandatory only for
9 complex structures **located in jurisdictions that offer electrical code plan review services.**

10 “**(2) The department shall adopt rules to make plumbing code plan review mandatory only**
11 **for complex structures located in jurisdictions that offer plumbing code plan review services.**

12 “[~~(2)~~] **(3)** Notwithstanding any rules adopted pursuant to [*subsection (1)*] **subsections (1) and (2)**
13 of this section, an owner of a complex structure or the owner’s agent may request and receive plan
14 review and inspections for any electrical and plumbing materials and installations that are subject
15 to the state building code.

16 “**SECTION 2.** If House Bill 3304 becomes law, section 2, chapter 288, Oregon Laws 2005
17 (Enrolled House Bill 3304) (amending ORS 455.483), is repealed.

18 “**SECTION 3.** This 2005 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public
19 peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2005 Act takes effect
20 on its passage.”.
