

# House Bill 3102

Sponsored by Representative KOMP; Representatives BARKER, BOONE, BURLEY, DALLUM, HUNT, MACPHERSON

## SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Directs Office of Emergency Management to develop and operate first responder building mapping information system for publicly owned buildings.

## A BILL FOR AN ACT

1  
2 Relating to first responder building mapping information systems; creating new provisions; and  
3 amending ORS 401.270.

4 **Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

5 **SECTION 1. (1) As used in this section and section 2 of this 2005 Act:**

- 6 (a) "Emergency" has the meaning given that term in ORS 401.025.  
7 (b) "First responder" has the meaning given that term in ORS 682.025.  
8 (c) "Public body" has the meaning given that term in ORS 174.109.  
9 (d) "Publicly owned building" means a building owned by a public body.

10 (2) **The Office of Emergency Management shall, as authorized in ORS 401.280, seek funds**  
11 **to create a first responder building mapping information system for all publicly owned**  
12 **buildings in this state.**

13 (3) **Subject to available funds, the office, in consultation with the State Fire Marshal, the**  
14 **Department of State Police and emergency service agencies as defined in ORS 401.025, shall**  
15 **develop guidelines for creation of a first responder building mapping information system for**  
16 **publicly owned buildings. In developing the guidelines the office shall consider:**

17 (a) **The type of information to be included in the first responder building mapping infor-**  
18 **mation system. The information must include, but need not be limited to, building floor plans**  
19 **of publicly owned buildings, fire protection information, evacuation plans, utility information,**  
20 **known hazards and text and digital images showing emergency personnel contact informa-**  
21 **tion.**

22 (b) **Building mapping software standards that must be utilized by all public bodies par-**  
23 **ticipating in the first responder building mapping information system.**

24 (c) **The order in which publicly owned buildings are mapped.**

25 (d) **The method for making the information in the first responder building mapping in-**  
26 **formation system available. The method shall include detailed procedures and security sys-**  
27 **tems to ensure that the information is made available only to the public body that owns the**  
28 **building or to a first responder responding to an emergency at the building.**

29 (e) **Training guidelines for the use of the first responder building mapping information**  
30 **system by first responders, emergency service agencies and other providers of emergency**  
31 **services.**

**NOTE:** Matter in **boldfaced** type in an amended section is new; matter [*italic and bracketed*] is existing law to be omitted. New sections are in **boldfaced** type.

1 (4) Nothing in this section supersedes the authority of a public body to control and  
 2 maintain access to information within its own independent building mapping system.

3 **SECTION 2.** (1) Subject to available funds, the Office of Emergency Management shall  
 4 operate the first responder building mapping information system created under section 1 of  
 5 this 2005 Act.

6 (2) All public bodies must utilize building mapping software that complies with the  
 7 building mapping software standards developed under subsection (6) of this section for all  
 8 publicly owned buildings mapped.

9 (3) If, prior to the date when the first responder building mapping information system  
 10 becomes operational, a public body has utilized building mapping software standards com-  
 11 patible with the standards developed under subsection (6) of this section, the public body may  
 12 continue to use its own building mapping system unless the office provides funds to bring the  
 13 public body's mapping system in compliance with the system established under section 1 of  
 14 this 2005 Act.

15 (4) All buildings owned by public bodies or occupied by public body employees must be  
 16 mapped when funding is provided by the office. Nothing in this section or section 1 of this  
 17 2005 Act requires any public body to map a building unless the entire cost of mapping the  
 18 building is provided by the office.

19 (5) After the first responder building mapping information system is operational, a public  
 20 body shall forward to the office the building mapping information for each building that it  
 21 owns that is mapped. The office may refuse any building mapping information that does not  
 22 comply with the guidelines developed under section 1 of this 2005 Act.

23 (6) Consistent with the guidelines developed under section 1 of this 2005 Act, the office  
 24 shall:

25 (a) Make the building mapping information electronically available to all public bodies,  
 26 the Oregon Military Department and fire departments; and

27 (b) Develop building mapping software standards that all public bodies participating in the  
 28 first responder building mapping information system must use.

29 (7) In addition to funds sought under section 1 of this 2005 Act, the office shall seek funds  
 30 as authorized under ORS 401.280 to provide grants to public bodies for the mapping of all  
 31 publicly owned buildings.

32 (8) The office may not disclose any building mapping information provided to the office  
 33 under this section except to the public body that owns the building and to an entity that is  
 34 responding to an emergency at the building.

35 **SECTION 3.** ORS 401.270 is amended to read:

36 401.270. The Director of the Office of Emergency Management shall be responsible for coordi-  
 37 nating and facilitating emergency planning, preparedness, response and recovery activities with the  
 38 state and local emergency services agencies and organizations, and shall, with the approval of the  
 39 Superintendent of State Police or as directed by the Governor:

40 (1) Make rules that are necessary and proper for the administration and implementation of ORS  
 41 401.015 to 401.105, 401.260 to 401.325, 401.355 to 401.580 and 401.706;

42 (2) Coordinate the activities of all public and private organizations specifically related to pro-  
 43 viding emergency services within this state;

44 (3) Maintain a cooperative liaison with emergency management agencies and organizations of  
 45 local governments, other states and the federal government;

1 (4) Have such additional authority, duties and responsibilities authorized by ORS 401.015 to  
2 401.105, 401.260 to 401.325 and 401.355 to 401.580 or as may be directed by the Governor;

3 (5) Administer grants relating to emergency program management and emergency services for  
4 the state;

5 (6) Provide for and staff a State Emergency Operations Center to aid the Governor and the Of-  
6 fice of Emergency Management in the performance of duties under ORS 401.015 to 401.105, 401.260  
7 to 401.325, 401.355 to 401.580 and 401.706;

8 (7) Serve as the Governor's authorized representative for coordination of certain response ac-  
9 tivities and managing the recovery process;

10 (8) Establish training and professional standards for local emergency program management per-  
11 sonnel;

12 (9) Establish task forces and advisory groups to assist the office in achieving mandated respon-  
13 sibilities; *[and]*

14 (10) Enforce compliance requirements of federal and state agencies for receiving funds and  
15 conducting designated emergency functions; **and**

16 (11) **Operate the first responder building mapping information system as provided in**  
17 **section 2 of this 2005 Act.**

18
