

HOUSE AMENDMENTS TO HOUSE BILL 3103

- 1 On page 1 of the printed bill, line 2, after "ORS" insert "497.006,".
- 2 Delete lines 30 and 31.
- 3 On page 2, delete lines 1 through 4 and insert:
- 4 "(j) Resident annual hunting license to hunt wildlife for active members of the Armed Forces
- 5 of the United States, free.
- 6 "(k) Resident annual hunting license to hunt wildlife for persons who have retired from the
- 7 Armed Forces of the United States within 12 months of the date of making an application for a li-
- 8 cense, free."
- 9 After line 6, insert:
- 10 "(3) As used in this section, 'active members of the Armed Forces of the United States' and
- 11 'Armed Forces of the United States' have the meanings given those terms in ORS 497.006."
- 12 Delete lines 32 through 36 and insert:
- 13 "(o) Resident annual angling license for active members of the Armed Forces of the United
- 14 States, free.
- 15 "(p) Resident annual angling license for persons who have retired from the Armed Forces of the
- 16 United States within 12 months of the date of making an application for a license, free."
- 17 After line 44, insert:
- 18 "(4) As used in this section, 'active members of the Armed Forces of the United States' and
- 19 'Armed Forces of the United States' have the meanings given those terms in ORS 497.006.
- 20 "**SECTION 3.** ORS 497.006 is amended to read:
- 21 "497.006. (1) As used in this section:
- 22 "(a) 'Active member of the Armed Forces of the United States' [*includes*] **means** officers and
- 23 enlisted personnel of the Armed Forces of the United States who:
- 24 "(A) Reside in this state while assigned to duty at any base, station, shore establishment or
- 25 other facility in this state;
- 26 "(B) Reside in this state while serving as members of the crew of a ship that has an Oregon port
- 27 or shore establishment as its home port or permanent station; or
- 28 "(C) Reside in another state or a foreign country and establish Oregon residency by filing
- 29 Oregon state income taxes no later than 12 months before leaving active duty.
- 30 "(b) 'Armed Forces of the United States' includes:
- 31 "(A) The Army, Navy, Air Force, Marine Corps and Coast Guard of the United States;
- 32 "(B) Reserve components of the Army, Navy, Air Force, Marine Corps and Coast Guard of the
- 33 United States; and
- 34 "(C) The National Guard of the United States and the Oregon National Guard.
- 35 "(c) 'Dependent children' includes any children of an active member of the Armed Forces of the

1 United States who:

2 “(A) Are under 18 years of age and not married, otherwise emancipated or self-supporting; or

3 “(B) Are under 23 years of age, unmarried, enrolled in a full-time course of study in an institu-
4 tion of higher learning and dependent on the member for over one-half of their support.

5 “(2) The following persons shall be considered resident persons for the purpose of purchasing
6 **or receiving** licenses, tags and permits issued by the State Fish and Wildlife Commission:

7 “(a) Active members of the Armed Forces of the United States who furnish to the commission
8 evidence satisfactory to the commission that the person is permanently assigned to active duty in
9 this state and the spouses and dependent children of such members.

10 “(b) Any active member of the Armed Forces of the United States who furnishes to the com-
11 mission evidence satisfactory to the commission that the person is a member of the Armed Forces
12 of the United States and the spouse and dependent children of such member.

13 “(c) Aliens who furnish to the commission evidence satisfactory to the commission that the
14 person is attending a school in this state pursuant to a foreign student exchange program.”.
