

CONFERENCE COMMITTEE AMENDMENTS TO B-ENGROSSED HOUSE BILL 3145

July 18

Amended Summary

Requires Oregon Department of Administrative Services to establish, after consultation and collaborative development with agencies, statewide information systems security plan and associated standards, policies and procedures.

Provides that Secretary of State, State Treasurer and Attorney General have sole discretion and authority over information systems security in their respective agencies.

Requires Secretary of State, State Treasurer and Attorney General to each establish information systems security plan and associated standards, policies and procedures in collaboration with Oregon Department of Administrative Services.

Declares emergency, effective on passage.

Speaker Minnis:

Your Conference Committee to whom was referred B-engrossed House Bill 3145, having had the same under consideration, respectfully reports it back with the recommendation that the House concur in the Senate amendments dated July 1 and that the bill be amended as follows and repassed.

- 1 On page 1 of the printed B-engrossed bill, line 17, delete “may” and insert “shall”.
2 After line 24, insert:
3 “(4) The Oregon Department of Administrative Services shall contract with qualified, independ-
4 ent consultants for the purpose of conducting vulnerability assessments under subsection (3) of this
5 section.”.
6 In line 25, delete “(4)” and insert “(5)”.
7 On page 2, line 10, delete “(5)” and insert “(6)”.
8 In line 16, delete “(5)” and insert “(6)”.
9 In line 25, delete “(6)” and insert “(7)”.
10 In line 28, delete “(4)” and insert “(5)”.
11 In line 30, delete “(7)(a)” and insert “(8)(a)”.
12 In line 43, delete “(8)” and insert “(9)”.
13 On page 3, line 7, delete “(9)” and insert “(10)”.
14 In line 14, delete “may” and insert “shall”.
15 Delete lines 18 and 19 and insert:
16 “(3) The plan established under subsection (2) of this section, at a minimum, must:”.
17 On page 4, line 6, delete “may” and insert “shall”.
18 After line 14, insert:
19 **“SECTION 3. The Secretary of State, the State Treasurer and the Attorney General shall**
20 **establish the initial plans required by section 2 (2) of this 2005 Act no later than January 1,**
21 **2007.”.**
22 In line 15, delete “3” and insert “4”.
