

SENATE AMENDMENTS TO HOUSE BILL 3179

- 1 On page 1 of the printed bill, line 2, after “702.017,” insert “702.022,”.
2 In line 3, delete “702.022 and”.
- 3 On page 4, line 15, after “(1)” insert “and (2)” and delete “(2)” and insert “(3)”.
- 4 On page 5, line 40, delete the period and insert “and, if requested by the department, shall allow
5 the department to take fingerprints for a criminal records check conducted pursuant to ORS 702.022.
6 “(2)”.
- 7 In line 41, delete “(2)” and insert “(3)”.
- 8 On page 6, line 33, delete “(2)” and insert “(3)”.
- 9 In line 36, delete “(1)” and insert “(2)”.
- 10 On page 7, line 6, delete “\$250” and insert “\$150”.
- 11 On page 11, delete line 43 and insert:
12 “**SECTION 22.** ORS 702.022 is amended to read:
13 “702.022. (1) The Department of Education may request, and the Department of State Police
14 shall furnish to the Department of Education, information on an individual that the Department of
15 State Police possesses in the central bureau of criminal identification, including but not limited to
16 manual or computerized information required for purposes of issuing **a certificate of registration**
17 **to an athlete agent** [*permits*] under ORS 702.012 and 702.017 **or a temporary certificate of regis-**
18 **tration to an athlete agent under section 6 of this 2005 Act.**
- 19 “(2) After furnishing the information obtained under subsection (1) of this section, the Depart-
20 ment of State Police shall conduct a nationwide criminal records check of the individual through the
21 Federal Bureau of Investigation, including records of fingerprints, and report the results to the De-
22 partment of Education.
- 23 “(3) The Federal Bureau of Investigation shall either return or destroy the fingerprint cards
24 used to conduct the criminal records check and shall not keep any record of the fingerprints.
25 However, if the federal bureau policy authorizing return or destruction of the fingerprint cards is
26 changed, the Department of Education shall not send the cards to the federal bureau but shall
27 continue to process the information through other available resources.
- 28 “(4) If the Federal Bureau of Investigation returns the fingerprint cards to the Department of
29 State Police, the Department of State Police shall return the fingerprint cards to the Department
30 of Education. The Department of Education shall destroy the fingerprint cards and shall not keep
31 any facsimiles or other material from which a fingerprint can be reproduced.
- 32 “(5) For purposes of receiving the information described in this section, the Department of Ed-
33 ucation is considered to be a designated agency as defined in ORS 181.010.
- 34 “**SECTION 23. ORS 702.042 is repealed.**”
