

# House Bill 3199

Sponsored by Representative ROBLAN; Representatives BARKER, BOONE, BRUUN, BUCKLEY, HASS, HOLVEY, HUNT, KRIEGER, MARCH, NOLAN, OLSON, RILEY, THATCHER, TOMEI, WITT

## SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Creates crime of possessing or disposing of methamphetamine manufacturing waste.  
Punishes by maximum of five years' imprisonment, \$125,000 fine, or both.

## A BILL FOR AN ACT

1  
2 Relating to methamphetamine.

3 **Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

4 **SECTION 1. (1) As used in this section:**

5 (a) **"Dispose of" means to discharge, deposit, inject, spill, leak or place methamphetamine**  
6 **manufacturing waste into or on the land or water.**

7 (b) **"Methamphetamine manufacturing waste" means a precursor substance, chemical**  
8 **waste or debris, used in or resulting from the manufacture of methamphetamine or the**  
9 **preparation of a precursor substance for the manufacture of methamphetamine.**

10 (2) **A person commits the crime of possessing or disposing of methamphetamine manu-**  
11 **facturing waste if the person:**

12 (a) **Knowingly possesses methamphetamine manufacturing waste; or**

13 (b) **Intentionally disposes of methamphetamine manufacturing waste.**

14 (3) **Subsection (2) of this section does not apply to the possession or disposal of meth-**  
15 **amphetamine manufacturing waste if:**

16 (a) **The person was storing, treating or disposing of the waste pursuant to state or fed-**  
17 **eral laws regulating the cleanup or disposal of waste products from unlawful methamphet-**  
18 **amine manufacturing;**

19 (b) **The person has notified a law enforcement agency of the existence of the waste; or**

20 (c) **The person possesses or disposes of waste that had previously been disposed of by**  
21 **another on the person's property in violation of subsection (2) of this section.**

22 (4) **Possessing or disposing of methamphetamine manufacturing waste is a Class C felony.**
