

House Bill 3414

Sponsored by Representatives HUNT, GILMAN; Representatives BRUUN, BURLEY, FLORES, SCHAUFLE, THATCHER

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Requires Department of Transportation to report to interim committee on funding options for highway projects of statewide significance.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to a report by the Department of Transportation.

3 **Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

4 **SECTION 1. The Department of Transportation shall develop a list of options for funding**
5 **the projects of statewide significance that are on the list of projects adopted by the Oregon**
6 **Transportation Commission in May 2002. The department shall present a report on the**
7 **options to the Legislative Committee on Transportation established by ORS 171.595, or an-**
8 **other committee charged with considering transportation matters, during the interim be-**
9 **tween the regular sessions of the Seventy-third and Seventy-fourth Legislative Assemblies.**

10 **SECTION 2. Section 1 of this 2005 Act is repealed on the date of the convening of the next**
11 **regular biennial legislative session.**
