SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure.

Directs Department of Human Services to **develop proposal to** establish pilot program with mental health organization providing mental health services in rural counties to pursue creation of local pool of federal, state, local and private funds to procure greater medical assistance from federal financial participation. **Directs department to seek federal approval of proposal.**
Sunsets January 2, 2012.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to delivery of mental health services.

3 **Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

4 **SECTION 1. (1) The Department of Human Services shall develop a proposal to establish**
5 **a pilot program with a mental health organization that contracts with the department on a**
6 **prepaid capitated basis under ORS 414.725 and that provides mental health services in no**
7 **fewer than 10 rural counties. The purpose of the pilot program is to enhance the delivery of**
8 **mental health services in rural counties by pursuing the creation of a local pool of federal,**
9 **state, local and private funds to procure greater medical assistance from federal financial**
10 **participation to maximize the amount of moneys available for mental health services.**

11 **(2) The department shall seek necessary federal approval of the proposal for the pilot**
12 **program.**

13 **(3) Not later than February 1 of each odd-numbered year, the department shall submit**
14 **to the Legislative Assembly a report on the proposal for the pilot program.**

15 **SECTION 2. Section 1 of this 2005 Act is repealed on January 2, 2012.**
