CHAPTER

AN ACT

Relating to motor racing tracks; and declaring an emergency.

Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:

SECTION 1. (1) Subject to subsection (2) of this section, a motor sports race track that existed on or before January 1, 1969, and that has been in continuous use without interruption or abandonment since January 1, 1969, is a permitted use in an exclusive farm use zone.

(2) The owner of a motor sports race track described by subsection (1) of this section:

(a) Shall abide by all ordinances applicable to an exclusive farm use zone;

(b) May allow only those race vehicles that are suitable for the type of race track; and

(c) May allow races or operation of race vehicles on the race track until 10 p.m. every night of the week if suitable lighting is installed that illuminates the track.

(3) As used in this section, "race vehicle" includes but is not limited to go-carts, race karts, motorcycles and all-terrain vehicles.

SECTION 2. This 2005 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2005 Act takes effect on its passage.
