

## HOUSE AMENDMENTS TO HOUSE BILL 3486

1 On page 1 of the printed bill, delete lines 19 through 22.

2 In line 23, restore the bracketed material and delete the boldfaced material.

3 On page 2, line 2, restore “(c)” and delete “(d)”.

4 In line 4, restore “(b)” and delete “(c)”.

5 Delete lines 16 through 24 and insert:

6 “(b) Notwithstanding paragraph (a) of this subsection, the department may not use the Internet  
7 to make information available to the public except as required by paragraph (c) of this subsection.

8 “(c) Notwithstanding subsections (2) and (3) of this section, the department shall use the Internet  
9 to make the information described in paragraph (d) of this subsection available to the public if the  
10 information is about a person:

11 “(A) Determined to be a predatory sex offender, as provided in ORS 181.585, who has also been  
12 determined, pursuant to rules of the agency making the predatory sex offender determination, to  
13 present the highest risk of reoffending and to require the widest range of notification; or

14 “(B) Found to be a sexually violent dangerous offender under ORS 144.635.

15 “(d) The information required to be made available under paragraph (c) of this subsection is:

16 “(A) The person’s name and address;

17 “(B) A physical description of the person including, but not limited to, the person’s age, height,  
18 weight and eye and hair color;

19 “(C) The type of vehicle that the person is known to drive;

20 “(D) Any conditions or restrictions upon the person’s probation, parole, post-prison supervision  
21 or conditional release;

22 “(E) A description of the person’s primary and secondary targets;

23 “(F) A description of the person’s method of offense;

24 “(G) A current photograph of the person;

25 “(H) If the person is under supervision, the name or telephone number of the person’s parole  
26 and probation officer; and

27 “(I) If the person is not under supervision, contact information for the Department of State Po-  
28 lice.”.

29 After line 36, insert:

30 “**SECTION 3. The amendments to ORS 181.592 by section 1 of this 2005 Act become op-  
31 erative on July 1, 2006.**

32 “**SECTION 4. The Department of State Police may take any action before the operative  
33 date of the amendments to ORS 181.592 by section 1 of this 2005 Act that is necessary to  
34 enable the department to exercise, on and after that date, the duties imposed on the de-  
35 partment by the amendments to ORS 181.592 by section 1 of this 2005 Act.**”.
