## SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Directs Department of Human Services to direct no less than \$15 million for 2005-2007 biennium from Tobacco Use Reduction Account to tobacco prevention and education programs.

## A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to funding for programs to reduce tobacco use.

3 **Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

4 **SECTION 1. (1) For the 2005-2007 biennium, the Department of Human Services shall di-**  
5 **rect no less than \$15 million from the Tobacco Use Reduction Account established under ORS**  
6 **431.832 to tobacco prevention and education programs.**

7 **(2) The department shall allocate funds for tobacco prevention and education programs**  
8 **after consideration of the Best Practices for Comprehensive Tobacco Control Programs**  
9 **published by the United States Department of Health and Human Services, Centers for Dis-**  
10 **ease Control and Prevention, National Center for Chronic Disease Prevention and Health**  
11 **Promotion, Office on Smoking and Health, August 1999.**
