

HOUSE AMENDMENTS TO HOUSE BILL 5019

By JOINT COMMITTEE ON WAYS AND MEANS

1 Delete lines 4 through 22 of the printed bill and insert:

2 **“SECTION 1. Notwithstanding ORS 137.300, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2005, the**
3 **Department of Revenue shall distribute:**

4 **“(1) 67.43 percent of the moneys in the Criminal Fine and Assessment Account, reduced**
5 **by the amount reported by the Department of Justice to the Department of Revenue under**
6 **ORS 137.300 (4), to the General Fund to be used for general governmental expenses; and**

7 **“(2) 32.57 percent of the moneys in the account to the Criminal Fine and Assessment**
8 **Public Safety Fund.**

9 **“SECTION 2. The allocation of the Criminal Fine and Assessment Public Safety Fund**
10 **made by this 2005 Act supersedes, replaces and is in lieu of any allocation of such funds in**
11 **prior years.**

12 **“SECTION 3. There are allocated to the Department of Public Safety Standards and**
13 **Training for the biennium beginning July 1, 2005, from the Criminal Fine and Assessment**
14 **Public Safety Fund the following amounts for the following purposes:**

- 15 (1) **Police Standards and Training**
16 **Account for criminal**
17 **justice training and**
18 **standards operations..... \$ 19,188,582**
19 (2) **Public Safety Memorial Fund**
20 **established under ORS 243.950.. \$ 104,962**

21 **“SECTION 4. (1) There are allocated to the Department of Human Services for the**
22 **biennium beginning July 1, 2005, from the Criminal Fine and Assessment Public Safety Fund**
23 **the following amounts for the following purposes:**

- 24 (a) **Domestic Violence Fund**
25 **for the purposes of**
26 **ORS 108.620 (1)(a) to (c)..... \$ 2,157,784**
27 (b) **Sexual Assault Victims Fund.... \$ 532,342**

28 **“(2) Notwithstanding ORS 137.302, there is allocated to the Department of Human Ser-**
29 **vices for the biennium beginning July 1, 2005, from the Criminal Fine and Assessment Public**
30 **Safety Fund the amount of \$315,000 for the purposes of the Emergency Medical Services and**
31 **Trauma Systems Program created under ORS 431.623.**

32 **“SECTION 5. There is allocated to the Department of State Police for the biennium be-**
33 **ginning July 1, 2005, from the Criminal Fine and Assessment Public Safety Fund the amount**
34 **of \$1,051,174 for officer training.**

35 **“SECTION 6. There are allocated to the Department of Justice for the biennium begin-**

1 **ning July 1, 2005, from the Criminal Fine and Assessment Public Safety Fund the following**
2 **amounts for the following purposes:**

- 3 (1) **Criminal Injuries Compensation**
4 **Account..... \$ 6,496,035**
- 5 (2) **Services to children eligible**
6 **for compensation under**
7 **ORS 147.390 and costs to**
8 **administer provision of these**
9 **services, which costs may not**
10 **exceed five percent \$ 749,280**
- 11 (3) **Child Abuse Multidisciplinary**
12 **Intervention Account..... \$ 7,298,296**
- 13 (4) **Creation and operation of a**
14 **statewide system of regional**
15 **assessment centers as provided**
16 **under ORS 418.780 to 418.796 \$ 886,403**

17 **“SECTION 7. This 2005 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public**
18 **peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2005 Act takes effect**
19 **July 1, 2005.”.**
