

# A-Engrossed House Bill 5019

Ordered by the House August 2

## SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure.

Directs distribution of moneys from Criminal Fine and Assessment Account to General Fund for general governmental expenses **and to Criminal Fine and Assessment Public Safety Fund**. Allocates moneys from Criminal Fine and Assessment Public Safety Fund to Department of Public Safety Standards and Training, **Department of Human Services, Department of State Police and Department of Justice**.

Declares emergency, effective July 1, 2005.

### A BILL FOR AN ACT

1  
2 Relating to state financial administration; and declaring an emergency.

3 **Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

4       **SECTION 1. Notwithstanding ORS 137.300, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2005, the**  
5 **Department of Revenue shall distribute:**

6           **(1) 67.43 percent of the moneys in the Criminal Fine and Assessment Account, reduced**  
7 **by the amount reported by the Department of Justice to the Department of Revenue under**  
8 **ORS 137.300 (4), to the General Fund to be used for general governmental expenses; and**

9           **(2) 32.57 percent of the moneys in the account to the Criminal Fine and Assessment**  
10 **Public Safety Fund.**

11       **SECTION 2. The allocation of the Criminal Fine and Assessment Public Safety Fund**  
12 **made by this 2005 Act supersedes, replaces and is in lieu of any allocation of such funds in**  
13 **prior years.**

14       **SECTION 3. There are allocated to the Department of Public Safety Standards and**  
15 **Training for the biennium beginning July 1, 2005, from the Criminal Fine and Assessment**  
16 **Public Safety Fund the following amounts for the following purposes:**

17           **(1) Police Standards and Training**  
18               **Account for criminal**  
19               **justice training and**  
20               **standards operations..... \$ 19,188,582**

21           **(2) Public Safety Memorial Fund**  
22               **established under ORS 243.950.. \$ 104,962**

23       **SECTION 4. (1) There are allocated to the Department of Human Services for the**  
24 **biennium beginning July 1, 2005, from the Criminal Fine and Assessment Public Safety Fund**  
25 **the following amounts for the following purposes:**

5       **(2) Notwithstanding ORS 137.302, there is allocated to the Department of Human Services**  
6       **for the biennium beginning July 1, 2005, from the Criminal Fine and Assessment Public**  
7       **Safety Fund the amount of \$315,000 for the purposes of the Emergency Medical Services and**  
8       **Trauma Systems Program created under ORS 431.623.**

9       **SECTION 5. There is allocated to the Department of State Police for the biennium be-**  
10       **ginning July 1, 2005, from the Criminal Fine and Assessment Public Safety Fund the amount**  
11       **of \$1,051,174 for officer training.**

12       **SECTION 6. There are allocated to the Department of Justice for the biennium beginning**  
13       **July 1, 2005, from the Criminal Fine and Assessment Public Safety Fund the following**  
14       **amounts for the following purposes:**

- 15       **(1) Criminal Injuries Compensation**
- 16           **Account..... \$ 6,496,035**
- 17       **(2) Services to children eligible**
- 18           **for compensation under**
- 19           **ORS 147.390 and costs to**
- 20           **administer provision of these**
- 21           **services, which costs may not**
- 22           **exceed five percent ..... \$ 749,280**
- 23       **(3) Child Abuse Multidisciplinary**
- 24           **Intervention Account..... \$ 7,298,296**
- 25       **(4) Creation and operation of a**
- 26           **statewide system of regional**
- 27           **assessment centers as provided**
- 28           **under ORS 418.780 to 418.796 .... \$ 886,403**

29       **SECTION 7. This 2005 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public**  
30       **peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2005 Act takes effect**  
31       **July 1, 2005.**
