

# Enrolled House Bill 5019

Ordered printed by the Speaker pursuant to House Rule 12.00A (5). Pre-session filed (at the request of Budget and Management Division, Oregon Department of Administrative Services)

CHAPTER .....

AN ACT

Relating to state financial administration; and declaring an emergency.

**Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

**SECTION 1. Notwithstanding ORS 137.300, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2005, the Department of Revenue shall distribute:**

**(1) 67.43 percent of the moneys in the Criminal Fine and Assessment Account, reduced by the amount reported by the Department of Justice to the Department of Revenue under ORS 137.300 (4), to the General Fund to be used for general governmental expenses; and**

**(2) 32.57 percent of the moneys in the account to the Criminal Fine and Assessment Public Safety Fund.**

**SECTION 2. The allocation of the Criminal Fine and Assessment Public Safety Fund made by this 2005 Act supersedes, replaces and is in lieu of any allocation of such funds in prior years.**

**SECTION 3. There are allocated to the Department of Public Safety Standards and Training for the biennium beginning July 1, 2005, from the Criminal Fine and Assessment Public Safety Fund the following amounts for the following purposes:**

- (1) Police Standards and Training Account for criminal justice training and standards operations..... \$ 19,188,582**
- (2) Public Safety Memorial Fund established under ORS 243.950.. \$ 104,962**

**SECTION 4. (1) There are allocated to the Department of Human Services for the biennium beginning July 1, 2005, from the Criminal Fine and Assessment Public Safety Fund the following amounts for the following purposes:**

- (a) Domestic Violence Fund for the purposes of ORS 108.620 (1)(a) to (c)..... \$ 2,157,784**
- (b) Sexual Assault Victims Fund.... \$ 532,342**

**(2) Notwithstanding ORS 137.302, there is allocated to the Department of Human Services for the biennium beginning July 1, 2005, from the Criminal Fine and Assessment Public Safety Fund the amount of \$315,000 for the purposes of the Emergency Medical Services and Trauma Systems Program created under ORS 431.623.**

**SECTION 5.** There is allocated to the Department of State Police for the biennium beginning July 1, 2005, from the Criminal Fine and Assessment Public Safety Fund the amount of \$1,051,174 for officer training.

**SECTION 6.** There are allocated to the Department of Justice for the biennium beginning July 1, 2005, from the Criminal Fine and Assessment Public Safety Fund the following amounts for the following purposes:

- (1) Criminal Injuries Compensation  
Account..... \$ 6,496,035
- (2) Services to children eligible  
for compensation under  
ORS 147.390 and costs to  
administer provision of these  
services, which costs may not  
exceed five percent ..... \$ 749,280
- (3) Child Abuse Multidisciplinary  
Intervention Account..... \$ 7,298,296
- (4) Creation and operation of a  
statewide system of regional  
assessment centers as provided  
under ORS 418.780 to 418.796 .... \$ 886,403

**SECTION 7.** This 2005 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2005 Act takes effect July 1, 2005.
