SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Appropriates moneys from General Fund to Secretary of State for biennial expenses.
Limits biennial expenditures from fees, moneys or other revenues, including Miscellaneous Receipts, but excluding lottery funds and federal funds, collected or received by Secretary of State.
Limits biennial expenditures of Secretary of State from federal funds.
Declares emergency, effective July 1, 2005.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

1
2 Relating to the financial administration of the Secretary of State; appropriating money; limiting
3 expenditures; and declaring an emergency.

4 **Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

5 **SECTION 1. There is appropriated to the Secretary of State, for the biennium beginning**
6 **July 1, 2005, out of the General Fund, the amount of \$8,071,283.**

7 **SECTION 2. Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the amount of**
8 **\$41,115,784 is established for the biennium beginning July 1, 2005, as the maximum limit for**
9 **payment of expenses from fees, moneys or other revenues, including Miscellaneous Receipts,**
10 **but excluding lottery funds and federal funds, collected or received by the Secretary of State.**

11 **SECTION 3. Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the amount of**
12 **\$5,555,479 is established for the biennium beginning July 1, 2005, as the maximum limit for**
13 **payment of expenses from federal funds collected or received by the Secretary of State.**

14 **SECTION 4. This 2005 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public**
15 **peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2005 Act takes effect**
16 **July 1, 2005.**
