

HOUSE AMENDMENTS TO HOUSE BILL 5068

By JOINT COMMITTEE ON WAYS AND MEANS

1 Delete lines 5 through 18 of the printed bill and insert:

2 “**SECTION 1.** Notwithstanding any other provision of law, in addition to the amount ap-
3 propriated by section 1, chapter 497, Oregon Laws 2003, for the biennium ending June 30,
4 2005, as modified by Emergency Board action, there is appropriated out of the General Fund
5 to the Department of Revenue, for the biennium ending June 30, 2005, the amount of
6 \$8,800,000 for the purpose of administrative expenses.

7 “**SECTION 2.** Notwithstanding any other provision of law, the General Fund appropriation
8 made to the Department of Revenue by section 2, chapter 497, Oregon Laws 2003, for the
9 biennium ending June 30, 2005, for the purpose of making payments authorized by ORS
10 307.244 and 310.630 to 310.706 for the elderly rental assistance program, as modified by
11 Emergency Board action, is decreased by \$1,100,000.

12 “**SECTION 3.** Notwithstanding any other provision of law, in addition to the amount ap-
13 propriated by section 1 (2), chapter 678, Oregon Laws 2003, for the biennium ending June 30,
14 2005, as modified by Emergency Board action, there is appropriated out of the General Fund
15 to the State Forestry Department, for the biennium ending June 30, 2005, the amount of
16 \$1,350,000 for the purpose of purchasing catastrophic fire suppression cost insurance for the
17 2005 fire season.

18 “**SECTION 4.** Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures of the Oregon De-
19 partment of Administrative Services for the payment of operating expenses of the depart-
20 ment from fees, moneys or other revenues, including Miscellaneous Receipts, but excluding
21 lottery funds and federal funds, for the biennium ending June 30, 2005, the limitation on
22 expenditures established by section 2 (1), chapter 389, Oregon Laws 2003, as modified by
23 Emergency Board action, is decreased by \$7,661,605.

24 “**SECTION 5.** Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the amount of
25 \$7,661,605 is established for the biennium ending June 30, 2005, as the maximum limit for
26 payment of expenses from fees, moneys or other revenues, including Miscellaneous Receipts,
27 but excluding lottery funds and federal funds, collected or received by the Oregon Depart-
28 ment of Administrative Services for implementation costs of the computing and networking
29 infrastructure consolidation project.

30 “**SECTION 6.** Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the amount of
31 \$325,000 is established for the biennium ending June 30, 2005, as the maximum limit for pay-
32 ment of expenses from fees, moneys or other revenues, including Miscellaneous Receipts, but
33 excluding lottery funds and federal funds, collected or received by the Oregon Department
34 of Administrative Services for costs of issuance of certificates of participation for the com-
35 puting and networking infrastructure consolidation project.

1 **“SECTION 7. This 2005 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public**
2 **peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2005 Act takes effect**
3 **on its passage.”.**
