

## HOUSE AMENDMENTS TO HOUSE BILL 5083

By SPECIAL COMMITTEE ON BUDGET

1 Delete lines 5 through 18 of the printed bill and insert:

2 **“SECTION 1. There is appropriated to the Water Resources Department, for the**  
3 **biennium beginning July 1, 2005, out of the General Fund, the amount of \$21,064,664 for water**  
4 **resources programs.**

5 **“SECTION 2. Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the following amounts**  
6 **are established for the biennium beginning July 1, 2005, as the maximum limits for payment**  
7 **of expenses from fees, moneys or other revenues, including Miscellaneous Receipts, and in-**  
8 **cluding federal funds received under cooperative agreements with or contracts from the**  
9 **Bureau of Reclamation of the United States Department of the Interior, the United States**  
10 **Army Corps of Engineers, the United States Geological Survey and the Pacific Northwest**  
11 **Electric Power and Conservation Planning Council, but excluding lottery funds and federal**  
12 **funds not described in this section, collected or received by the Water Resources Depart-**  
13 **ment, for the following purposes:**

14 (1) Water resources program..... \$ 6,249,562

15 (2) Water Development Fund

16 loan administration..... \$ 317,155

17 **“SECTION 3. Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the amount of**  
18 **\$1,137,424 is established for the biennium beginning July 1, 2005, as the maximum limit for**  
19 **payment of expenses from federal funds other than those described in section 2 of this 2005**  
20 **Act collected or received by the Water Resources Department.**

21 **“SECTION 4. For the biennium beginning July 1, 2005, expenditures by the Water Re-**  
22 **sources Department for debt service and loans for water development projects are not lim-**  
23 **ited.**

24 **“SECTION 5. This 2005 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public**  
25 **peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2005 Act takes effect**  
26 **July 1, 2005.”.**
