SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure.

- Appropriates moneys from General Fund to Water Resources Department for biennial expenses.
- Limits biennial expenditures from fees, moneys or other revenues, including Miscellaneous Receipts, but excluding lottery funds and certain federal funds, collected or received by Water Resources Department.
- Limits biennial expenditures by Water Resources Department from certain federal funds.
- Authorizes specified nonlimited expenditures.
- Declares emergency, effective July 1, 2005.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

Relating to state financial administration; appropriating money; limiting expenditures; and declaring an emergency.

Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:

SECTION 1. There is appropriated to the Water Resources Department, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2005, out of the General Fund, the amount of \$20,844,664 for water resources programs.

SECTION 2. Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the following amounts are established for the biennium beginning July 1, 2005, as the maximum limits for payment of expenses from fees, moneys or other revenues, including Miscellaneous Receipts, and including federal funds received under cooperative agreements with or contracts from the Bureau of Reclamation of the United States Department of the Interior, the United States Army Corps of Engineers, the United States Geological Survey and the Pacific Northwest Electric Power and Conservation Planning Council, but excluding lottery funds and federal funds not described in this section, collected or received by the Water Resources Department, for the following purposes:

- (1) Water resources program..... \$ 6,249,562
- (2) Water Development Fund
loan administration..... \$ 317,155

SECTION 3. Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the amount of \$1,137,424 is established for the biennium beginning July 1, 2005, as the maximum limit for payment of expenses from federal funds other than those described in section 2 of this 2005 Act collected or received by the Water Resources Department.

SECTION 4. For the biennium beginning July 1, 2005, expenditures by the Water Re-

3 **SECTION 5.** This 2005 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public
4 peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2005 Act takes effect
