SUMMARY

Appropriates moneys from General Fund to [_____] **Public Defense Services Commission for certain** biennial expenses.

Limits biennial expenditures from fees, moneys or other revenues, including Miscellaneous Receipts, but excluding lottery funds and federal funds, collected or received by [_____] **commission.**

[Limits biennial expenditures by _____ from federal funds.]

Declares emergency, effective July 1, 2005.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to state financial administration; appropriating money; limiting expenditures; and declaring
3 an emergency.

4 **Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

5 **SECTION 1. There are appropriated to the Public Defense Services Commission, for the**
6 **biennium beginning July 1, 2005, out of the General Fund, the following amounts for the fol-**
7 **lowing purposes:**

8 (1) **Legal Services..... \$ 6,071,432**

9 (2) **Public Defense Services**

10 **Account \$166,349,886**

11 (3) **Contract and Business Services \$ 2,433,248**

12 **SECTION 2. Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the amount of \$953,206**
13 **is established for the biennium beginning July 1, 2005, as the maximum limit for payment of**
14 **expenses from fees, moneys or other revenues, including Miscellaneous Receipts, but ex-**
15 **cluding lottery funds and federal funds, collected or received by the Public Defense Services**
16 **Commission, for the Contract and Business Services Division.**

17 **SECTION 3. This 2005 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public**
18 **peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2005 Act takes effect**
19 **July 1, 2005.**
