

# A-Engrossed House Bill 5098

Ordered by the House May 26  
Including House Amendments dated May 26

Sponsored by COMMITTEE ON ELECTIONS AND RULES

## SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure.

*[Appropriates moneys from General Fund to \_\_\_\_\_ for biennial expenses.]*  
Limits biennial expenditures from fees, moneys or other revenues, including Miscellaneous Receipts, but excluding lottery funds and federal funds, collected or received by *[\_\_\_\_\_]* **State Marine Board**.  
Limits biennial expenditures by *[\_\_\_\_\_]* **board** from federal funds.  
Declares emergency, effective July 1, 2005.

## A BILL FOR AN ACT

Relating to state financial administration; limiting expenditures; and declaring an emergency.

**Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

**SECTION 1. Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the following amounts are established for the biennium beginning July 1, 2005, as the maximum limits for payment of expenses from fees, moneys or other revenues, including Miscellaneous Receipts, but excluding lottery funds and federal funds, collected or received by the State Marine Board, for the following purposes:**

- (1) Administration and education... \$ 4,829,922
- (2) Marine law enforcement..... \$ 9,420,583
- (3) Facilities construction and  
maintenance and land  
acquisition..... \$ 9,350,212

**SECTION 2. Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the following amounts are established for the biennium beginning July 1, 2005, as the maximum limits for payment of expenses from federal funds collected or received by the State Marine Board, for the following purposes:**

- (1) Administration and education... \$ 116,127
- (2) Marine law enforcement..... \$ 2,238,141
- (3) Facilities construction and  
maintenance and land  
acquisition..... \$ 2,745,388

**SECTION 3. This 2005 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2005 Act takes effect July 1, 2005.**
