**SUMMARY**

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure.

*[Appropriates moneys from General Fund to \_\_\_\_\_ for biennial expenses.]*  
Limits biennial expenditures from fees, moneys or other revenues, including Miscellaneous Receipts, but excluding lottery funds and federal funds, collected or received by [\_\_\_\_\_] **State Department of Energy.**

**Authorizes specified nonlimited expenditures.**

Limits biennial expenditures by [\_\_\_\_\_] **department** from federal funds.

Declares emergency, effective July 1, 2005.

**A BILL FOR AN ACT**

2 Relating to state financial administration; limiting expenditures; and declaring an emergency.

3 **Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

4 **SECTION 1. Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the amount of**  
5 **\$17,928,322 is established for the biennium beginning July 1, 2005, as the maximum limit for**  
6 **payment of expenses from fees, moneys or other revenues, including Miscellaneous Receipts,**  
7 **but excluding lottery funds and federal funds, collected or received by the State Department**  
8 **of Energy.**

9 **SECTION 2. For the biennium beginning July 1, 2005, expenditures by the State Depart-**  
10 **ment of Energy for loans for small scale energy loan projects and expenditures by the de-**  
11 **partment for debt service are not limited.**

12 **SECTION 3. Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the amount of**  
13 **\$5,433,356 is established for the biennium beginning July 1, 2005, as the maximum limit for**  
14 **payment of expenses from federal funds collected or received by the State Department of**  
15 **Energy.**

16 **SECTION 4. This 2005 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public**  
17 **peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2005 Act takes effect**  
18 **July 1, 2005.**
