SUMMARY

[Limits biennial expenditures from fees, moneys or other revenues, including Miscellaneous Receipts, but excluding lottery funds and federal funds, collected or received by _____.]
[Limits biennial expenditures by _____ from federal funds.]

Appropriates moneys from General Fund to Insurance Pool Governing Board for biennial expenses.

Limits biennial expenditures from fees, moneys or other revenues, including Miscellaneous Receipts, but excluding lottery funds and federal funds, collected or received by board.

Limits biennial expenditures from moneys collected or received by board from Department of Human Services.

Declares emergency, effective July 1, 2005.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to state financial administration; appropriating money; limiting expenditures; and declaring
3 an emergency.

4 **Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

5 **SECTION 1. There is appropriated to the Insurance Pool Governing Board, for the**
6 **biennium beginning July 1, 2005, out of the General Fund, the amount of \$26,315,139.**

7 **SECTION 2. Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the amount of**
8 **\$1,770,925 is established for the biennium beginning July 1, 2005, as the maximum limit for**
9 **payment of expenses from fees, moneys or other revenues, including Miscellaneous Receipts,**
10 **but excluding lottery funds and federal funds, collected or received by the Insurance Pool**
11 **Governing Board.**

12 **SECTION 3. Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the amount of**
13 **\$65,849,523 is established for the biennium beginning July 1, 2005, as the maximum limit for**
14 **payment of expenses from moneys collected or received by the Insurance Pool Governing**
15 **Board from the Department of Human Services.**

16 **SECTION 4. This 2005 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public**
17 **peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2005 Act takes effect**
18 **July 1, 2005.**
