

## HOUSE AMENDMENTS TO HOUSE BILL 5113

By SPECIAL COMMITTEE ON BUDGET

1 Delete lines 5 through 18 of the printed bill and insert:

2 **“SECTION 1. There are appropriated to the Oregon Student Assistance Commission, for**  
3 **the biennium beginning July 1, 2005, out of the General Fund, the following amounts for the**  
4 **following purposes:**

- 5 (1) **Financial aid payments to**  
6 **individuals and institutions..... \$ 64,607,781**  
7 (2) **Operations..... \$ 1,664,352**

8 **“SECTION 2. Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the amount of**  
9 **\$3,584,419 is established for the biennium beginning July 1, 2005, as the maximum limit for**  
10 **payment of expenses from fees, moneys or other revenues, including Miscellaneous Receipts,**  
11 **but excluding federal funds, lottery moneys allocated from the Education Stability Fund for**  
12 **Oregon Opportunity Grants and those funds described in section 5 of this 2005 Act, collected**  
13 **or received by the Oregon Student Assistance Commission.**

14 **“SECTION 3. Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the amount of**  
15 **\$1,051,930 is established for the biennium beginning July 1, 2005, as the maximum limit for**  
16 **payment of expenses from federal funds collected or received by the Oregon Student Assist-**  
17 **ance Commission.**

18 **“SECTION 4. Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the amount of**  
19 **\$1,527,619 is established for the biennium beginning July 1, 2005, as the maximum limit for**  
20 **payment of expenses from lottery moneys allocated from the Education Stability Fund to the**  
21 **Oregon Student Assistance Commission for Oregon Opportunity Grants.**

22 **“SECTION 5. For the biennium beginning July 1, 2005, expenditures by the Oregon Stu-**  
23 **dent Assistance Commission for the following activities are not limited:**

24 **“(1) Making disbursements of grants from private and special scholarship accounts as**  
25 **established by the Legislative Assembly; and**

26 **“(2) Making disbursements of educational benefits to individuals through the JOBS Plus**  
27 **Program.**

28 **“SECTION 6. This 2005 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public**  
29 **peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2005 Act takes effect**  
30 **July 1, 2005.”.**
