

HOUSE AMENDMENTS TO HOUSE BILL 5115

1 Delete lines 5 through 18 of the printed bill and insert:

2 **“SECTION 1. There is appropriated to the State Library, for the biennium beginning July**
3 **1, 2005, out of the General Fund, the amount of \$2,923,060.**

4 **“SECTION 2. Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the amount of**
5 **\$1,330,659 is established for the biennium beginning July 1, 2005, as the maximum limit for**
6 **payment of expenses from fees, moneys or other revenues, including Miscellaneous Receipts**
7 **other than those described in section 3 of this 2005 Act, but excluding lottery funds and**
8 **federal funds, collected or received by the State Library.**

9 **“SECTION 3. Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the amount of**
10 **\$5,279,071 is established for the biennium beginning July 1, 2005, as the maximum limit for**
11 **payment of expenses from moneys received from the assessment against state agencies de-**
12 **scribed in ORS 357.203 and transferred to the Miscellaneous Receipts Account for the State**
13 **Library.**

14 **“SECTION 4. Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the amount of**
15 **\$4,630,839 is established for the biennium beginning July 1, 2005, as the maximum limit for**
16 **payment of expenses from federal funds collected or received by the State Library.**

17 **“SECTION 5. This 2005 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public**
18 **peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2005 Act takes effect**
19 **July 1, 2005.”**
