

## HOUSE AMENDMENTS TO HOUSE BILL 5123

1 Delete lines 5 through 18 of the printed bill and insert:

2 **“SECTION 1. There is appropriated to the State Department of Geology and Mineral In-**  
3 **dustries, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2005, out of the General Fund, the amount of**  
4 **\$2,912,582 for operations of the department.**

5 **“SECTION 2. Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the amount of**  
6 **\$3,176,299 is established for the biennium beginning July 1, 2005, as the maximum limit for**  
7 **payment of expenses from fees, moneys or other revenues, including federal funds for con-**  
8 **tract services and Miscellaneous Receipts, but excluding lottery funds and federal funds not**  
9 **described in this section, collected or received by the State Department of Geology and**  
10 **Mineral Industries.**

11 **“SECTION 3. Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the amount of**  
12 **\$2,153,274 is established for the biennium beginning July 1, 2005, as the maximum limit for**  
13 **payment of expenses from federal funds other than those described in section 2 of this 2005**  
14 **Act, collected or received by the State Department of Geology and Mineral Industries.**

15 **“SECTION 4. This 2005 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public**  
16 **peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2005 Act takes effect**  
17 **July 1, 2005.”.**
