

# A-Engrossed House Bill 5125

Ordered by the House May 27  
Including House Amendments dated May 27

Sponsored by COMMITTEE ON ELECTIONS AND RULES

## SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure.

Appropriates moneys from General Fund to [\_\_\_\_\_] **Oregon Youth Authority** for **certain** biennial expenses.

Limits biennial expenditures from fees, moneys or other revenues, including Miscellaneous Receipts **and federal funds received from Department of Education and Department of Human Services for nutrition programs and alcohol and drug abuse prevention programs**, but excluding lottery funds and **other** federal funds, collected or received by [\_\_\_\_\_] **Oregon Youth Authority**.

Limits biennial expenditures by [\_\_\_\_\_] **Oregon Youth Authority** from federal funds.

Declares emergency, effective July 1, 2005.

## A BILL FOR AN ACT

Relating to state financial administration; appropriating money; limiting expenditures; and declaring an emergency.

**Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

**SECTION 1. There are appropriated to the Oregon Youth Authority, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2005, out of the General Fund, the following amounts for the following purposes:**

- (1) Operations..... \$199,687,404
- (2) Debt service ..... \$ 6,629,178
- (3) Capital improvements ..... \$ 611,891

**SECTION 2. Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the amount of \$12,530,758 is established for the biennium beginning July 1, 2005, as the maximum limit for payment of expenses from fees, moneys or other revenues, including Miscellaneous Receipts and including federal funds received from the Department of Education and the Department of Human Services for nutrition programs and alcohol and drug abuse prevention programs, but excluding lottery funds and federal funds not described in this section, collected or received by the Oregon Youth Authority.**

**SECTION 3. Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the amount of \$25,925,815 is established for the biennium beginning July 1, 2005, as the maximum limit for payment of expenses from federal funds, other than those described in section 2 of this 2005 Act, collected or received by the Oregon Youth Authority.**

**SECTION 4. This 2005 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2005 Act takes effect**
