

B-Engrossed House Bill 5125

Ordered by the Senate June 28

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure.

Appropriates moneys from General Fund to Oregon Youth Authority for certain biennial expenses.

Limits biennial expenditures from fees, moneys or other revenues, including Miscellaneous Receipts and federal funds received from Department of Education and Department of Human Services for nutrition programs and alcohol and drug abuse prevention programs, but excluding lottery funds and other federal funds, collected or received by Oregon Youth Authority **for certain purposes**.

Limits biennial expenditures by Oregon Youth Authority from federal funds.
Declares emergency, effective July 1, 2005.

4 **Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

5 **SECTION 1. There are appropriated to the Oregon Youth Authority, for the biennium**
6 **beginning July 1, 2005, out of the General Fund, the following amounts for the following**
7 **purposes:**

- 8 (1) **Operations..... \$200,063,103**
- 9 (2) **Debt service \$ 6,567,593**
- 10 (3) **Capital improvements \$ 630,815**

11 **SECTION 2. Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the following amounts**
12 **are established for the biennium beginning July 1, 2005, as the maximum limits for payment**
13 **of expenses from fees, moneys or other revenues, including Miscellaneous Receipts and in-**
14 **cluding federal funds received from the Department of Education and the Department of**
15 **Human Services for nutrition programs and alcohol and drug abuse prevention programs, but**
16 **excluding lottery funds and federal funds not described in this section, collected or received**
17 **by the Oregon Youth Authority, for the following purposes:**

- 18 (1) **Operations..... \$ 12,530,758**
- 19 (2) **Debt service \$ 61,585**

20 **SECTION 3. Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the amount of**
21 **\$25,925,815 is established for the biennium beginning July 1, 2005, as the maximum limit for**
22 **payment of expenses from federal funds, other than those described in section 2 of this 2005**
23 **Act, collected or received by the Oregon Youth Authority.**

24 **SECTION 4. This 2005 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public**
